## **ANSSACC Sports Scholarship – Information Sheet**

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- The scholarship is open to boys and girls aged under 18 years of age (as at the application close date of 28 February) and who are Australian residents.
- The athlete must not be on a scholarship from a government, school or other body (e.g. AIS, NSW Cricket, private school scholarship, etc).
- Applications must be made by a Member club on behalf of the athlete.
- The athlete or his / her parents must be a member of the club making the application.
- Applications (using a form to be provided by ANSSACC) must include the following information:
  - Full name and date of birth of child;
  - Photo which the applicant agrees can be used by ANSSACC on its website or other material such as official magazine and newsletters;
  - Personal statement from the athlete providing a biography, sporting accomplishments to date, future aspirations, why they should be considered a worthy recipient of the scholarship and how they would use it to promote sporting and academic achievement within in the Sikh community;
  - Copy of latest school report card or reference from school principal / teacher;
  - Details of previous appearances at Australian Sikh Games; and
  - Details on what the \$1,000 scholarship will be used for e.g. pay for training or physio sessions, purchase of equipment, travel cost to interstate school sports events, etc.
- Applications can be for any sport and are not just limited to the sports played at the Australian Sikh Games.

## Selection Criteria

- The scholarship must be awarded to a new athlete each year (i.e. an athlete can only receive it once). Athletes who are not awarded in a given year can reapply for the scholarship in a later year.
- Consideration will be given to the athlete's representative level (e.g. regional, zone, state or Australian representative).
- Consideration will be given to the athlete's academic record and / or feedback from school reference.
- Consideration will be given to the athlete's previous attendance at the Australian Sikh Games as an athlete or spectator and level of involvement with their club.
- Evaluation will be balanced between the above criteria.
- Award of scholarship to be decided by a vote of the Executive Committee members.
- Scholarship to be awarded at a presentation during the Australian Sikh Games. The athlete will be notified prior to the games (e.g. 2-3 weeks prior) and the athlete must agree be present at the games to receive the award.
